Be creative as you look around your home (or the home of a relative) for items that might provide clues about your ancestors.

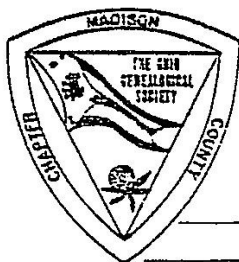
