GENEALOGY TIP

When you add a place in your genealogy software, always try to include the county, even if you have to look it up. Including the county is beneficial for a couple of reasons: (1) Records are often held at the county level, so knowing the county your ancestor resided in is helpful and (2) It helps you differentiate whether a locality is a city/town or the county of the same name. Citing the name of the township can also be helpful.

If you don't already routinely include the county when you're identifying a locality as a matter of course, I encourage you to make it a habit!

95th REGIMENT CO. B

R. M. HANSON, captain.--Enlisted July 24, '62. Captured June 10, '64, at Brices' X Roads, Miss. Escaped. Mustered out June 26, '64. Buried in Paint township cemetery.

CALEB MCPRIKE--Enlisted August 4, '62; mustered out August 4, '63. Buried in Paint township cemetery.

WILLIAM THORNBURG--Enlisted July 22, '62; died November 1, '62, in hospital at Vicksburg. Buried at Vicksburg, Tenn.

NATHAN C. MOORE--Enlisted August 26, '62; mustered out August 14, '65. Buried in Kirkwood cemetery, London, Ohio.

ERASTUS S. VENT--Enlisted August 4, '62; discharged March 20, '63, account of disability. Living in London, Ohio.

FRANCES M. EVANS--Enlisted July 24, '62; captured June 10, '64, at Brices' X Roads, Miss.; prisoner at Andersonville; mustered out August 14, '65. Buried at Paint township cemetery.

WILLIAM RUTTER--Enlisted July 26, '62; mustered out August 14, '65. Living in Columbus, Ohio.

WILLIAM B. STONE--Enlisted August 5, '62; buried in Miami County, Ohio.

JOHN EVANS--Enlisted July 26, '62; mustered out August 14, '65; buried in Missouri.

ADDISON HANSON--Enlisted August 11, '62; mustered out August 14, '65; buried in Paint township cemetery.

JOHN S. WITHROW--Enlisted August 5, '62; mustered out August 14, '65; living in California.

S. C. MEADE--Enlisted August 11, '62; discharged November 22, '62 for disability; living.

SAMUEL S. SMITH--Enlisted August 11, '62; wounded in battle at Richmond, Ky., January 12, '63.

The 95th was engaged in many important battles; Chickamauga, Lookout Mountain, Mission Ridge, Peach Tree Creek, Atlanta, Jonesboro, Franklin, Tenn., and other battles.
